Director of the Judicial Branch Certification Commission



Ronald Morgan is the Director of the Enterprise Planning and Regulatory Services Division at the Texas Office of Court Administration (OCA). In this role, he serves as Director of the Judicial Branch Certification Commission (the JBCC). The JBCC is the body charged with licensing and regulating court related professions, including Court Interpreters, Court Reporters, Guardians, and Process Servers. He has served in this role since January 2025.

Prior to joining OCA, Ron served as the Director of District Court Administration in Williamson County, Texas from late 2020 through January 2025. As the trial court administrator, Ron was responsible for managing daily operations and strategic planning for the District Courts. During his tenure, he assisted in passing legislation to add one court, managed facilities and IT projects, supervised staff and programs, obtained and

managed several grants, and oversaw the resumption of jury trials during the COVID 19 pandemic. Prior to his service in Williamson County, Ron held various positions in Travis County, including Chief Deputy County Clerk and Director of the Civil/Probate Division of the County Clerk's Office and in leadership roles at Travis County Pretrial Services. He has worked in various roles in the court system for over 23 years.

Ron holds a graduate degree from Texas State University-San Marcos and an undergraduate degree from Louisiana State University-New Orleans. He and his wife reside in Austin and are the very proud parents/chauffeurs of an active teenager.
